Position Summary:

The right person for this job will be someone with a passion to develop in each student an awareness of the role of science in economic and social progress; to motivate each pupil to acquire knowledge of scientific facts and principles, and skills in scientific methods of problem solving; to discover and develop special talents of pupils in scientific field. The teacher is responsible for planning and implementing lessons in accordance with the standards set forth by the CamdenForward School of UrbanPromise Ministries and Common Core standards.

Essential Job Functions:

- 1. Develops and implements weekly Science lesson plans that are in accordance and are consistent with the Camden Forward School program curriculum and the Common Core Standard guidelines.
- 2. Establish clear objectives for all lessons, units, and projects, and communicate those objectives to students. Administer standardized ability and achievement tests, and interpret results to determine student's developmental levels and needs. Plans a science program involving demonstrations, lectures, discussions, and student experiments; organizes laboratory activities for optimum learning. Demonstrates scientific concepts by use of scientific apparatus, experiments, and standard or teacher-prepared charts, sketches, and other instructional aids.
- 3. Demonstrate knowledge of content and pedagogy. Incorporate technology into the curriculum for Science. MS Science teacher provides individual or small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of pupils and to accommodate circumstances where a variety of projects and experiments are being worked on simultaneously.
- **4.** Uphold the UrbanPromise values (Faith, Innovation, Community, Holism) and demonstrate the character qualities of enthusiasm, courtesy, flexibility, integrity, gratitude, kindness, self-control, and perseverance.
- 5. Prepare students for later grades by encouraging them to explore learning opportunities and to persevere with challenging tasks. Cooperates with school administration in facilitating the annual school Science Fair, providing displays and programs for the school and community, and in sponsoring science activities. Instructs students in proper use, care, and safe handling of chemicals, science equipment, and plant and animal life. Provides for safe storage and proper use of materials, equipment, and tools. Makes minor adjustments and requests repairs to equipment as required.
- **6.** Clearly and consistently communicate, model, and enforce CFS behavior expectations with a goal of maintaining a safe, welcoming, and positive learning environment.
- **7.** Meet with parents and guardians to discuss their children's progress, and to determine their priorities for their children and their resource needs.
- **8.** Maintain accurate and complete student records, and prepare reports on students and activities, as required by laws, district policies, and administrative regulations. Science teacher will also comply with all UPM policies related to local, state, federal and employee handbook, COVID-19, and other health compliance policies.
- **9.** Employee is the caretaker of the campus butterfly garden. Employee will provide teaching staff and workgroups education on the campus mascot (the butterfly) and maintain the butterfly garden. *
- 10 <u>Other duties as assigned include but not limited to</u>: Assist in fund raising and in running both UPM and CFS special events and work closely with CFS team to continuously improve department-organization efforts. In addition, attend professional meetings, educational conferences, and teacher training workshops to maintain and improve professional competence.
